Participation in co-curricular programs is a privilege. Students and adults engaged in these activities are community ambassadors. As representatives of the school and community, it is essential that they conduct themselves with dignity and display good sportsmanship. Those who demonstrate the inability to meet these standards of conduct in school activities may be prohibited from representing the school at co-curricular events, as determined by school administration.
