AUGUST 19, 2014

The Stratton School Board held its first meeting of the 2014/2015 school year on August 19, 2014 at the Stratton Town Office. The meeting was called to order at 7 P.M.

- 6) Transportation forms that were mailed to parents have been completed and returned. The information will be used for those students planning to use the Winhall Bus service for the 2014/2015 school year.


OTHER BUSINESS:
