Bylaws

Supervisory Union Board

Membership: The WCSU Board will be comprised of three (3) voting members from each School Board that employs teachers and one (1) voting member from each School Board that does not employ teachers. The WCSU will elect a Chairperson, Vice Chairperson and Clerk. Those officers must be sitting WCSU Board members who were appointed by their respective board to serve on the WCSU Board. In the event that a designated Board member cannot attend a WCSU meeting, he/she may resign and that member's board may appoint a replacement at a duly warned meeting. If the replacement does not wish to complete the remainder of the terms, boards may re-appoint a member who resigned at a subsequent meeting.

Officers: Regular annual elections of officers shall take place not later than 30 days after the latest annual school district election held by a member district in the Supervisory Union. Officers shall serve for a term of one (1) year but may be re-elected to hold consecutive terms. Officers of the WCSU Board shall serve as officers of the Executive Committee, in the same corresponding capacities.

Meetings: The Supervisory Union Board shall meet upon the call of the Chairperson, one (1) or more times per year. All meetings are open, except when meeting in executive session, in accordance with applicable Vermont Statutes and Open Meeting Law.

Quorum: A majority of the school districts comprising the WCSU shall be represented and a majority of all members of the WCSU Board shall be present in order to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Voting: Elections and all SU business conducted at Supervisory Union Board meetings shall be determined by a majority vote of those present, provided that a quorum is present. A legal vote taken at such meeting shall be binding upon each school district in the Supervisory Union.

Authority: The WCSU Board will execute the powers and duties outlined in 16 V.S.A. §§ 241 and 261a (see addendum for current powers and duties) and any other applicable laws, provided that some of those specific powers and duties may be delegated to the Executive Committee by the WCSU Board through its Executive Committee by-laws as authorized by 16 V.S.A. 264(b).
